



Camp Wakonda COVID-19 Information

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, Camp Wakonda will be operating with the following procedures in order to keep campers, staff, and guests safe:

- All campers, staff, and guests will be required to wear masks during indoor activities (masks may be removed while sitting to eat at meals) and while unable to maintain social distance outdoors
- Kitchen staff will wear masks and gloves during all food preparation and service
- Meals will be served cafeteria-style, possibly with a staggered meal schedule
- Guests and family of campers will stay with their vehicle during check-in & pick-up procedures; arrival times will be staggered (this will be sent to you prior to your camp event)
- Campers must provide a 14-day temperature log at check-in; see the form provided
- A camp staff member will be doing daily temperature checks while campers are on-site
- Cabin groups will be paired, creating small explorer groups, for activities in order to limit potential whole-camp exposure
- Camp maintenance staff are cleaning and sanitizing high-touch surfaces multiple times each day
- As we learn more, additional procedures may be added (such as, but not limited to, requiring testing and/or vaccinations prior to arrival)
