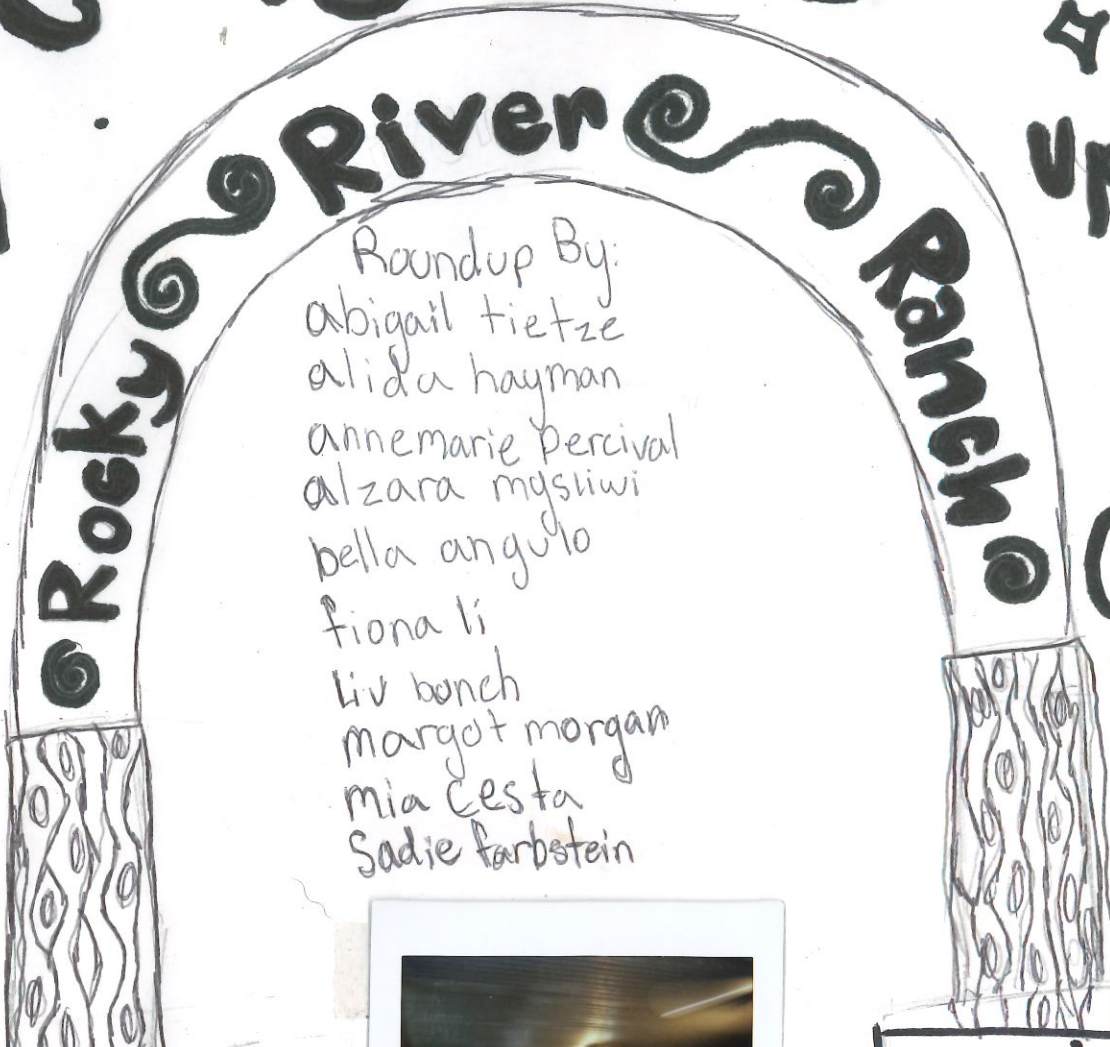

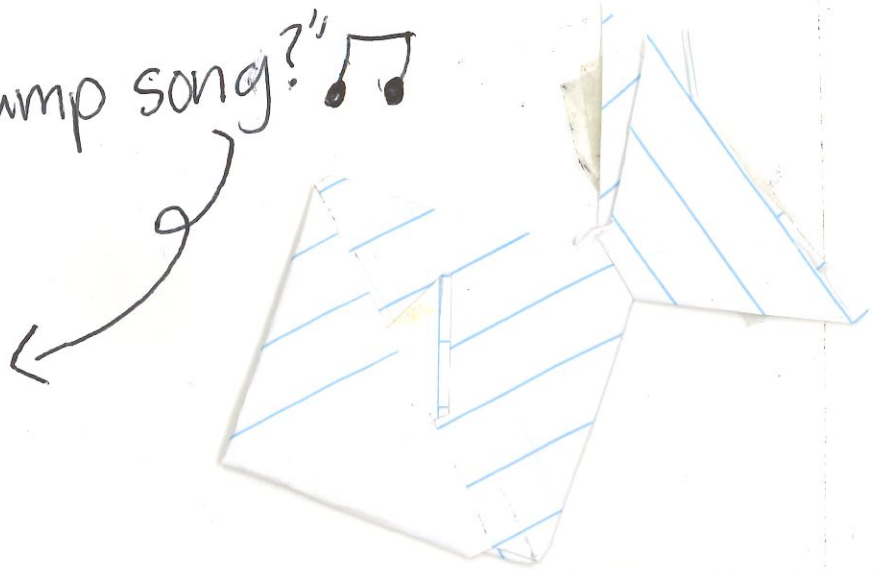
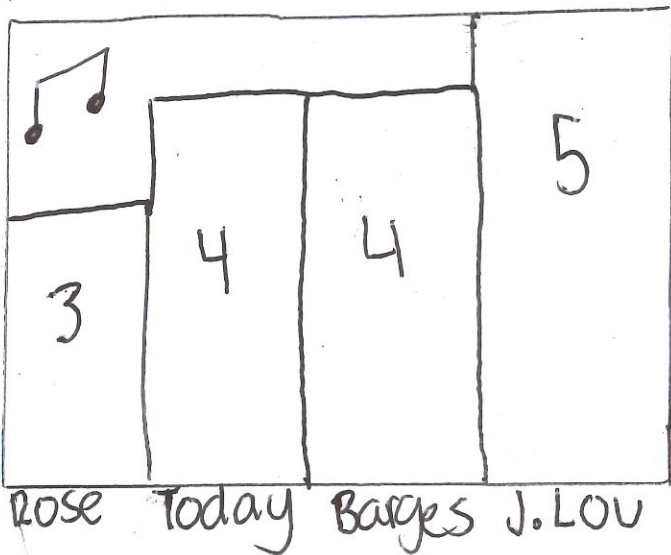

Sadie Farbstein

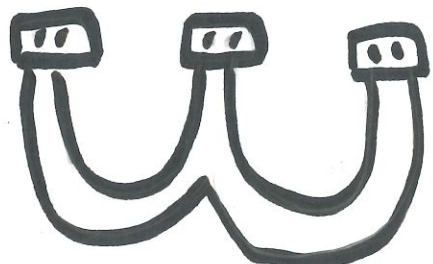
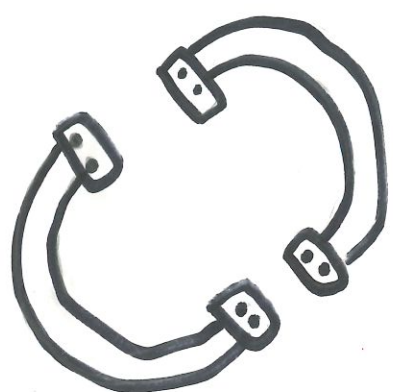
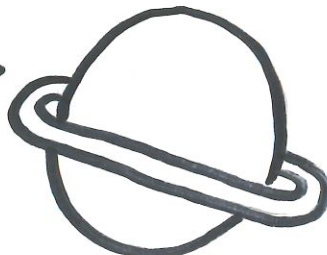
I am from Blanco Tx. This is my 5th year at camp. I am a Cowpoke. My fav. Memory is drawing the cowpoke chip from the hat
