

Materials List, Drawing New and Continuing, SBMA

1. Newsprint pad of paper (18" x 24")*
2. White drawing paper pad (18" x 24") (preferably with micro-perforated sheets for clean removal from pad)
3. Strathmore 400 series pastel paper sheets (for pastel drawing, toned or plain - sold in one sheet)
4. Compressed charcoal sticks
5. Vine charcoal sticks*
6. Charcoal pencils, one of each: 2B, 6B, and white
7. Graphite pencils, one of each: 4H, 2H; two of each HB, 2B, 4B, 6B, 8B/Ebony
8. Kneaded eraser
9. White plastic eraser
10. Tortillons / Blending stump; at least one of each: 1/2" diameter, 1/4" diameter (you may also purchase them in packs).
11. 3-micron pens; various sizes (optional)
12. Set of Nupastels (Pack of 12)
13. 18" metal cork-backed ruler
14. Two 2 1/2" bulldog clips
15. Roll of 1" blue painters / delicate surface
16. Workable fixative (optional, hold off)
17. Portfolio large enough to hold drawings (at least 23" x 31"); this can be the inexpensive version made from heavy paper. You can make your own by taping together cut cardboard as well.
18. An art supply box, or an inexpensive tackle box for organizing and transporting supplies.
19. Canister pencil sharpener
20. Cloth or rag (for blending)
21. India Ink
22. Sumi Brush and watercolor brushes of different sizes
23. Plastic cups for ink and water
