Weekly Schedule:

Monday, March 17: Nevada

We will start the day off with a fun camp mixer so campers can make new friends and create our camp constitution. Campers will then explore Idlewild Park with the Nevada Department of Wildlife and help them release native trout into the Truckee River!

Tuesday, March 18: Nepal

This day, campers will learn all about Nepal, from its culture to the historic Mt. Everest! Campers will create "summit signs" to prepare for tomorrow's field trip, where they will have the opportunity to hike to one of Reno's iconic summits: the 'N' on Peavine Peak above Rancho San Rafael Park.

Wednesday, March 19: Field Trip!

Campers will explore their local Northern Nevada hills with a hike and picnic at Rancho San Rafael Regional Park.

Thursday, March 20: Basque Country

Did you know the National Basque Festival happens every year in Elko, Nevada? Campers will explore Basque history and its connection to Northern Nevada, while learning new music, dances, and games.

Friday, March 21: Tuvalu

On our final day, campers will learn about the small island nation of Tuvalu, including environmental challenges and island culture. Plus, we will have a Fun Friday BBQ lunch!

Rules and Administrative Information:

- Please drop off your camper at 9:00 am at the California Building in Idlewild Park, located at 75 Cowan Dr, Reno, NV 89509 (If you have registered for extended hours, drop-off starts at 8:00 am)
 - *Campers with a fever or experiencing other flu-like symptoms will not be able to attend.*
- Pick-up and sign-out is at 4:00 pm. Campers will only be permitted to leave with an adult listed on the approved pick-up list with their ID. Please have your ID ready.
- If you have registered for extended hours, pick-up ends at 5:30 pm —campers *must* be picked up before then!

 There are no extended hours on Fridays. The camp day ends at 4:00 pm on Friday, March 21st.
- We highly recommend packing snacks for your child, as we will be outside and burning energy all day!
- It will be chilly throughout the day, so please make sure your camper is dressed appropriately for the weather. Please wear shoes/attire that you won't mind getting dirty. If it storms, we will move our camp indoors.

- Comfortable clothes, including a jacket, and closed-toed shoes
- Extra weather-appropriate clothes
- Nut-free snacks
- Backpack or bag
