

How to Pack your daughter's Medications for Camp

*All prescription and over-the-counter medications **that will be taken by a camper more than once during the camp session must be entered into UltraCamp system and have a Medication Administration Authorization Form signed by a healthcare provider uploaded.***

All prescription and over-the-counter medications brought to camp must

- be handed over to the nurse at check-in and kept secure in the infirmary
 - they will be returned to the authorized pick-up adult at check-out
- be in original containers/packaging/box
- have camper's first and last name should be written on the box
- be unexpired
- have enough doses for the duration of camp
- if applicable, be accompanied by the correct dosing instrument (cup, syringe, etc.)
- *if a prescription, with the prescription label attached*
 - There are specific instructions from the provider that are necessary for administration. This is especially important for any liquids/creams/ointments.
