

COVID DROP OFF & PICK-UP POLICIES RESIDENT (OVER NIGHT) & DAY CAMPERS

- 1. Resident Campers will have a staggered drop off and pick up with 15-30 minutes between each camper which will be assigned by Camp Agape
- 2. Nurse or health assistant will do a quick temperature check and health review for each camper with the parent at drop off
- 3. Nurse or health assistant will do a quick temperature check and health review for each camper with the parent at pick up
- 4. If a camper has a temperature of 99 or above the camper will not be permitted to come to camp
- 5. If a camper has any COVID-19 symptoms (Fever, Dry cough, Tiredness, Aches and pains, Sore throat, Diarrhea, Conjunctivitis, Headache, Loss of taste or smell, a rash on skin, or discoloration of fingers or toes, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, chest pain or pressure, or loss of speech of movement), the camper will not be permitted at camp.
- If a camper has been exposed to another person who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, the camper will not be permitted at camp until he or she has been quarantined for 10 days and has proof of a negative COVID-19 test.
- 7. ALL campers will be REQUIRED to wear masks and practice proper social distancing while on the campgrounds
- 8. Campers may remove their masks while eating and sleeping
- 9. The parents will be called to pick up any camper that REFUSES to wear their mask or practice safe social distancing while on the campgrounds
- 10. The parent(s) will be required to wear masks during drop off and pick up
- 11. If a parent or person assigned to do drop-off or pick-up has been exposed to COVID-19, they will need to make alternate arrangements for camper drop-off or pick-up until they have been quarantined for 10 days and have proof of a negative COVID-19 test
